Olympic artwork makes a splash at exhibition



Regent's Park Pools of colour representing the Olympic rings ripple and splash in an artwork inspired by the 2012 Games at the Kinetica Art Fair in Central London. Nimra Javaid, 23, created *Liquid Athletes*, with five other students from Thames Valley University, with an overhead projector, coloured plastic and a stereo. Water drips from the projectors into coloured pools of light creating ripples that symbolise the chain reaction of events and synchronise with the beat of a human heart. The exhibition at the Ambika P3 gallery, near Regent's Park, runs until Sunday.
